

CANDIDATES AT WILSON'S SCHOOL

SELECTIVE ELIGIBILITY TEST – TUESDAY 17 SEPTEMBER 2024

You should read this alongside the email giving your child's designated test centre, candidate number and where to report to on arrival. **Please print the email and provide your child with a copy to bring to the exam. This is needed on arrival. Do not show us the email on your phone.**

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR ARRIVAL AND COLLECTION

- **Check the weather forecast** and ensure you and your child are suitably dressed (you may need to be outside for a period of time)
- **Only one adult per candidate** (no siblings if at all possible)
- Please arrive within the designated time slot
- **Follow all instructions** and requests from school representatives
- **Leave promptly** once you have delivered your child/collected your child

For the afternoon session

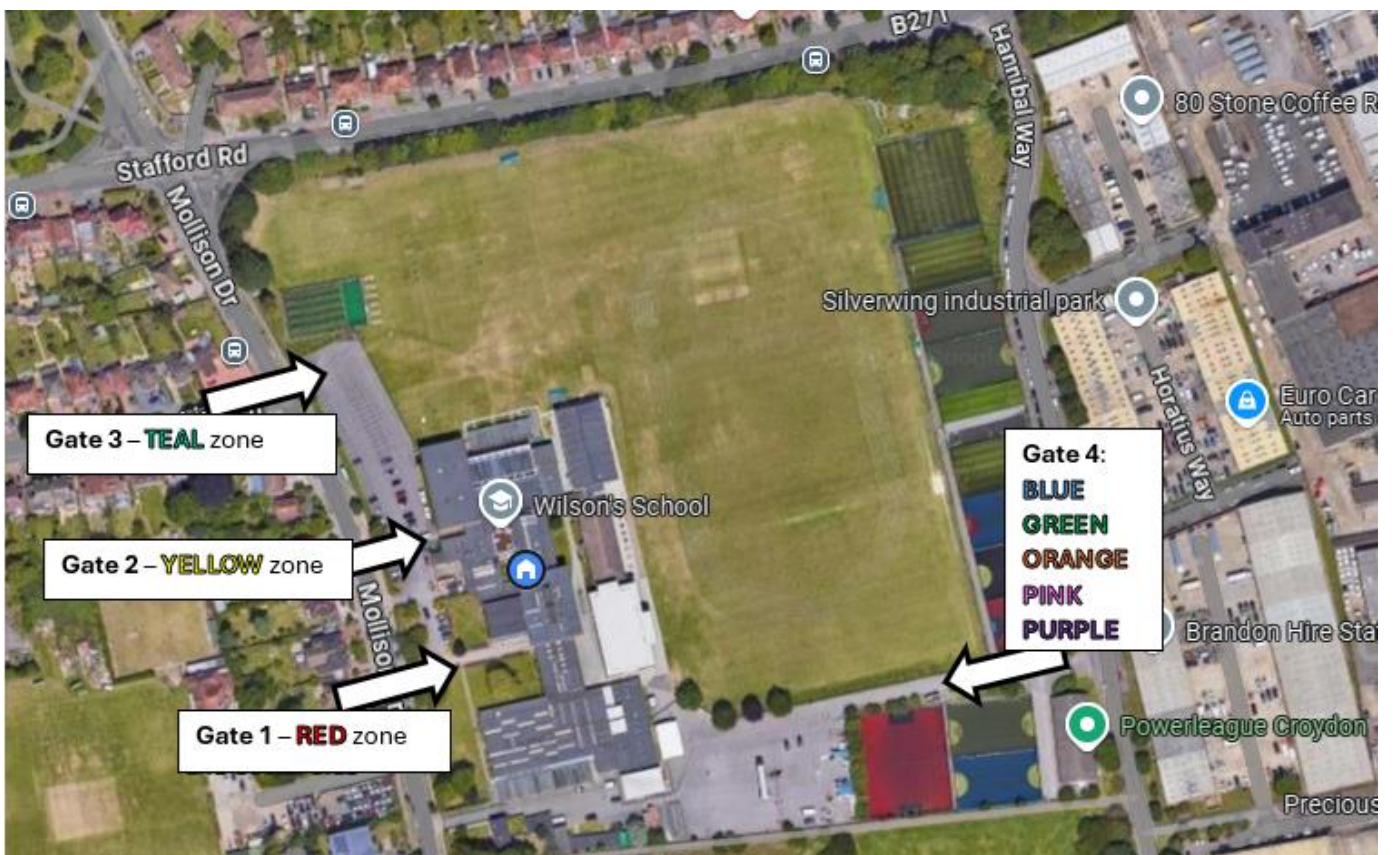
Arrive between 8.30am and 9.00am. Testing will begin by 9.15am
Arrive between 12.45pm and 1.15pm. Testing will begin by 1.30pm

During these arrival times school staff, the school's CCF cadets and Sixth Form Prefects will be at the entrances and will take your child to his allocated seat in the school.

WHAT TO DO ON ARRIVAL:

Please ensure that you arrive (on foot) at the correct entry point as per your email:

Gate 1	Mollison Drive - Black School Gates to Main Reception (RED zone)
Gate 2	Mollison Drive - Green School Gates (YELLOW zone)
Gate 3	Mollison Drive - Green school gates, nearest junction with Stafford Rd (TEAL zone)
Gate 4	Hannibal Way - Gate entrance near Power League (BLUE, GREEN, ORANGE, PINK and PURPLE zones)



PICK-UP ARRANGEMENTS

Morning session ends 11.15am approx

Afternoon session ends 3.30pm approx

Please go (on foot) to collect your child from the same point you arrived as follows:

Gate 1, 2 and 3– Mollison Drive - collect your child from the large area accessed through the green school gates.

Gate 4 – Hannibal Way - collect your child from the large playground area via the gate near Powerleague wait by the alphabet letter for the first letter of your child's last name. Your child will be escorted out to you. Leave promptly when you have been reunited. End times are approximate. We would be grateful for your patience.

Do not tell your child to meet you outside the school.

TRAVEL TO WILSON'S SCHOOL

Read the information on the website about travel to Wilson's School. You are strongly recommended to park further away and walk to the site or to use public transport. **There will be no parking available on site or around the site (parking restrictions will be in operation and parking attendants will be patrolling the area).** Do not try to enter Hannibal Way in your vehicle. It is most important that you do not park your car within a mile of the school so as not to inconvenience local residents and businesses. There are public car parking facilities available in Wallington at the following locations SM6 9BX, SM6 0PW, SM6 0EU, SM6 0DZ and the school is accessible from Wallington by foot or bus (157, 154, S4) and from Waddon rail station.

WHAT CANDIDATES MUST BRING

- A **printout** of the email giving candidate number and arrival point. This is very important. If you don't have access to a printer you can write your son's name, date of birth and candidate number on a piece of paper.
- Two or more HB or B pencils, a soft rubber and a pencil sharpener and a ruler in a clear plastic pencil case or bag.
- A jumper or fleece.

They may also bring:-

- A bottle of water (no fizzy drinks) in a clear plastic sports cap bottle and a snack (no nuts).
- A book to read before the tests start and during the break. Make sure the book is one that your son really enjoys as he may be waiting in his test room for an extended period before the tests start.
- A small pack of tissues.

Your child should not bring a mobile telephone or any other electronic device, a calculator or calculator watch or smartwatch; any watch that beeps; any piece of stationery that displays times tables or other such information or a dictionary.

Please do not send your child to the exam with a large backpack/bag as space in the exam areas is limited.
