

## SCHOOL VISITS AND OTHER OFF SITE ACTIVITIES

### Parent/Carer Consent

Please indicate your consent to the following:

I am happy for my child:

- a) to take part in school visits and other activities that take place off school premises; and
- b) to be given first aid or urgent medical treatment during any school visit or activity.

Please note the following important information before giving this consent:

The visits and activities covered by this consent include:

- all off site visits, school representative activities, sporting fixtures and other activities during the school day and outside of the school day
- all visits including residential trips which take place outside the school day, or during the holidays or a weekend
- adventure activities at any time

The school will give you information about each visit or activity before it takes place.

You can, if you wish, tell the school that you do not want your child to take part in any particular school visit or off-site activity.

Written parental consent may not be requested from you for off-site activities offered by the school – for example, year group visits to a museum – particularly when such activities are part of the school's curriculum and usually take place during the normal school day.

The school will take emergency contact details and information about any medical condition(s) that your child suffers from and any medication(s) that your child should take during off site visits from the information you have given on this Admission Form (which will be transferred to the school's information system) and any updates to information throughout your child's time at the school. You must ensure that the information held by the school is kept up to date by informing us promptly of any changes.
