

## Example year 7 Student Work – French

The following gives some examples of the level of work covered in french in Year 7 including details of how we expect students to set out their work and engage with feedback received. Students who follow these steps, review which of the Core Concepts requires the most development and responds to the individual feedback they have been given, will make the most progress.

### Classwork and homework

All work has a date and a title which has been underlines.

The objective of the lesson is recorded.

## REMEMBER

### Grammar

1. The nouns are either feminine, masculine or plural
2. Always use an article with nouns in French
3. The = le / la / les or l'

Le = the (masculine)

La = the (feminine)

Les = the (plural)

L' = the (when the noun starts with a vowel)

If a noun ends with an -e, the noun is feminine (95% reliable rule)

### être = to be

Personnes	Je	suis (I am)
	Tu	es (You are)
	il	est (He is)
	elle	est (She is)
	vous	êtes (you lot are)
	ils / elles	sont (they are)

AVOIR

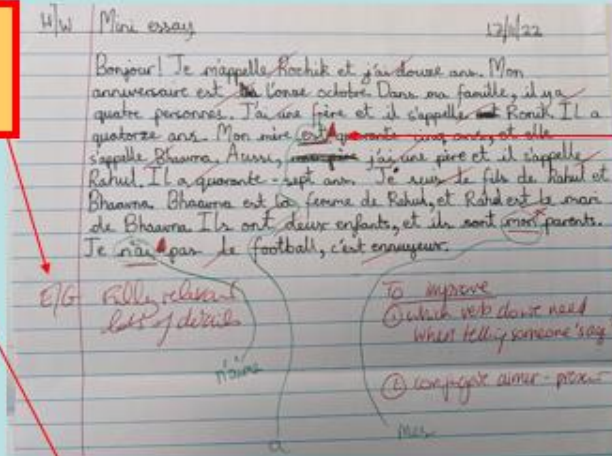
Students have taken pride in their work. Not just great handwriting, but also making sure that key grammatical points are highlighted. This is particularly important in the core concepts of grammar and writing.

**Teacher assessed work:**

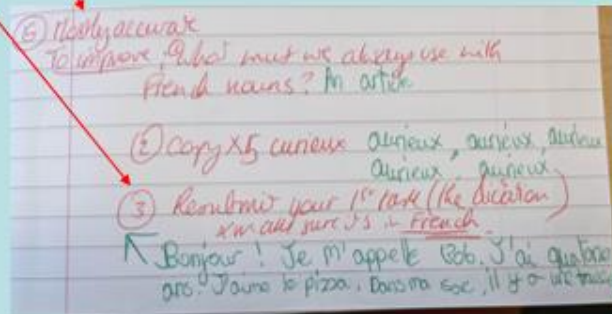
A diligence grade is given.
